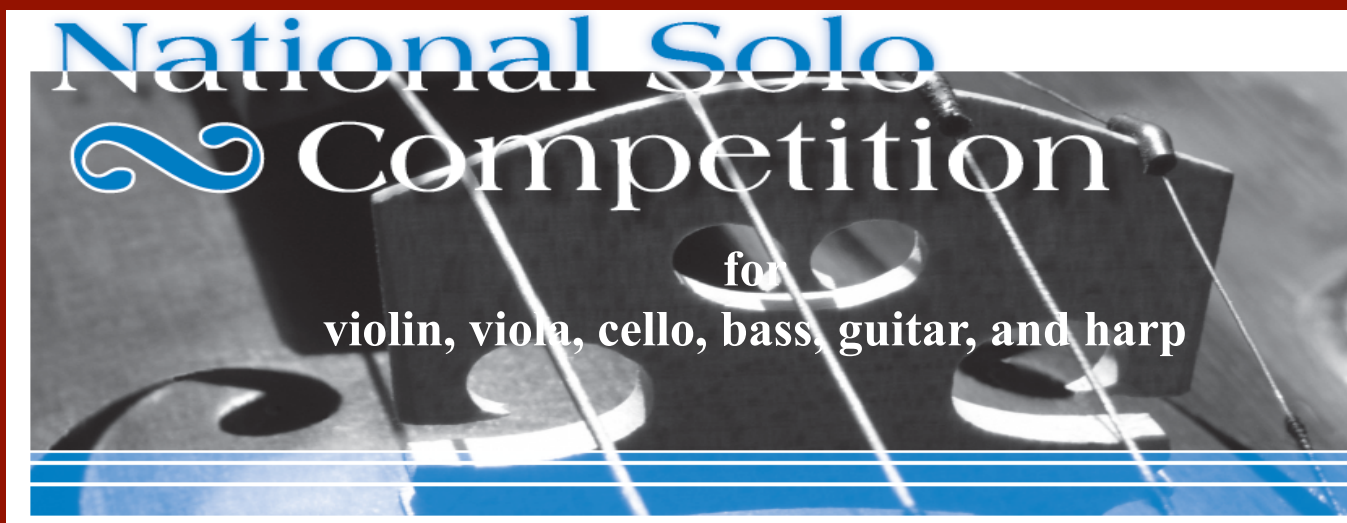

Texas has been well represented in the past national competitions, and we would like for all teachers to continue this tradition by encouraging their students to participate this year. So start preparing them now for this fantastic opportunity!

All participants or their teachers must be members of ASTA. Entrants can choose to enter in the state where they live or where they study. All Texas participants must enter via the state chapter competition, which serves as the preliminary round of the national competition. This preliminary round is by CD. Entries must include a recording of all the required repertoire (repertoire list available on the ASTA website), National Solo Competition Official Entry Form (available on the ASTA website), proof of date of birth, proof of student and/or teacher ASTA membership, \$40 state entrance fee, and \$75 national entrance fee. All required materials to enter the competition must be received by the TexASTA Solo Competition Chair before October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 at the address above.
